## Farm Show Facts

- The Pennsylvania Farm Show is the largest indoor agricultural event in America with **10,000 competitive exhibits** and nearly **300 commercial exhibitors**. Nearly **400,000 visitors** attend the show each year.
- The Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex and Expo Center houses **24 acres under roof**, spread throughout 11 buildings and three arenas.
- Eleven commodity groups offer the state's best beef, pork, chicken, potatoes, mushrooms, honey, maple products, baked goods and milkshakes in the Farm Show Food Court and Annex.
- Farm Show visitors have a sweet tooth. Nearly **100,000 milkshakes, 20,000 dozen potato doughnuts, 7,000 apple dumplings, 11,000 whoopie pies, and nearly 900 gallons of honey ice cream** were consumed during last year's show.
- More than **6,000 head** of sheep, swine, horses, cattle, goats, poultry and rabbits will compete during the Pennsylvania Farm Show for more than **\$548,000 in premiums**.
- The 2011 4-H and FFA Sale of Champions brought \$43,200 for the grand and reserve grand champion beef, sheep, swine and goat winners. The champion steer brought \$10,000, the champion lamb brought \$4,700, the champion swine brought \$6,500, and the champion goat brought \$4,000.
- The Farm Show Scholarship Foundation has invested **\$886,500 in scholarships** to junior Farm Show exhibitors in its 18-year history. In 2011, 25 students each received a \$3,500 scholarship.
- The Family Living Center consists of more than an acre of family living, horticultural, environmental and 4-H and FFA demonstrations and exhibits, including more than **10 baking contests**.
- Several contests feature local and state celebrities milking and showing dairy cows, driving draft horses, or making burgers and other food items.
- Show-goers can take a spin on a **60-year-old art deco merry-go-round** with 30 horses and two chariot seats. Tickets are \$2, and last year \$30,217 was raised with half of the proceeds benefiting the Pennsylvania Farm Show Scholarship Foundation and the addition funds supporting the Pennsylvania Showmen's Association scholarship fund.
- The horseshoe pitching contest began in 1931 and was a hit for 25 years. The contest was reintroduced as a competition in 2007, and is considered one of the most prestigious tournaments in the National Horseshoe Pitchers Association.
- More than **2,000 FFA members** will gather for the Pennsylvania FFA Mid-Winter Convention during Farm Show as the group bestows Keystone Degrees and Pennsylvania State Star awards.
- **Tractors can square dance!** Two teams consisting of two callers and 14 drivers maneuver tractors of all shapes, sizes and color around the Large Arena in time to music.
- Youth visitors can "investigate" the show by becoming a Farm Show Detective. Designed to teach kids about agriculture, they can visit **22 learning stations** throughout the complex by following a map. Participants can register and enter to win prizes from sponsor Turkey Hill, just like Lancaster County first-grader Heidi Weiler who won a year's supply of ice cream.
- The Farm Show Press Office writes more than **80 news releases** and takes thousands of photos during show week to highlight the events, shows and award winners. Each day the information is posted at [www.farmshow.state.pa.us](http://www.farmshow.state.pa.us) and a list is sent to the media.
