### ENTRIES CLOSE NOVEMBER 3, 2011

1. Eligibility - Only registered animals may be shown in the Open Boer Goat Show. All Boer goats must be registered in the herd-book of a recognized association before the date of the show. Recognized associations include Int'l BGA, ABGA, The IBGA, USBGA, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association.
2. All animals must be registered purebred, fullblood or percentage blood Boer goats. Percentage doe classes must be 50% to 88%, Purebred/ Fullblood doe classes must be 15/16 blood (94%) and higher. Bucks must be 31/32 blood (97%) and higher.
3. An original certificate is required for all animals six (6) months of age or older. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor on or before the date of the show.
4. An original certificate or stamped duplicate registration application is required on all animals under six (6) months of age. No faxed copies of certificates or registration applications will be accepted.
5. Re-tattoo's are acceptable when said tattoo matches the legible digits of the original tattoo, is in the same ear as the original tattoo, and an appropriate notification appears on the animal's registration certificate.
6. Ages will be determined by the birth date on the registration certificate and calculated to December 31, 2011.
7. Animals with natural horns, disbudded, or dehorned may be shown without regards to discrimination.
8. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased within ninety (90) days of the show.
9. In classes where there is no competition, awards shall be made by the judge according to the merit of the animal. In class(s) where the quality of the animal(s) is **not** of Champion consideration type, the judge shall begin the class(s) with a second place ribbon and the animal(s) shall not compete for Champion or Reserve Champion.
10. Any Boer doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded shall not be allowed to show.
11. An exhibitor shall be limited to two entries in any one class. Entry fee is \$8.00 per head.
12. Champion Classes - Competition will be limited to first and second place animals.
13. GROOMING - Use only grooming products that are approved for the use on meat producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, DO NOT use it.
14. Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes.
15. Arrival - Meat (Open Boer) Goats must arrive by 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2012. Pens will be open to receive animals 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2012. All goats must be checked in with the Superintendent by 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, January, 2011. Release time is 2:00 p.m. Saturday, January 14, 2012.
16. Substitutions are allowed in the same class only and must have same ownership as the original entry. Substitutions will be made at check-in
17. Health: See Goats, page 19 and all entries in these classes will also be subject to the General Rules and Regulations page 16.

1. All applications for entry must be made on printed livestock entry forms, giving all necessary information. These forms must be signed by the exhibitor, parent or guardian and certified by a county agent, a staff member of the Extension Service, an agricultural education teacher or vocational supervisor. Entries must be postmarked by November 3, 2011. Entries may also be made online at www.farmshow.state.pa.us by the entry deadline.
2. Entry fees - no entry fee.
3. All animals must be owned by and be in the possession of the exhibitor by November 3, 2011. In the name of the junior exhibitor only.
4. An animal may show in one division only. Meat Breeding does cannot show in the Market Goat Division and visa versa.
5. Boer Goats must be registered as full bloods or purebred Boer goats to show in Boer Classes. Percentage Boer goats must have papers listing the animal as a percentage Boer to show in percentage classes. All non-papered animals will show in crossbred classes.
6. Health - See page 19 for health rule requirements. All entries in these classes will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations on page 16. All entries entered in the Open Boer Goat Show will be subject to the Open Boer Goat Show rules and regulations found on page 95.
7. **GROOMING:** Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat and milk producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat and milk producing animals, don't use it.
8. Arrival - Junior Meat Breeding Goats must arrive by 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2012. Pens will be open to receive animals 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2012. All goats must be checked in with the Superintendent by 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, January 11, 2012.
9. Meat Breeding Goats Released 2:00 p.m. Saturday, January 14, 2012 and must depart by midnight.
10. Transportation Allowance: See Rule 27, page 17 and chart on page 20.

**JUNIOR MEAT BREEDING GOAT SHOWMANSHIP**

Jr. Breeding Goat Showmanship skills will be recognized by designating "Master Showmen" in each breeding class. Exhibitors who demonstrate extraordinary skills in showing their animals will be selected by a separate showmanship judge during the show. The number will be recorded and the exhibitor will be awarded a special Farm Show Award. There will be no further showmanship competition for Jr. Breeding Goat exhibitors.
