No Entry Fee

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 10:30 A.M., FRIDAY, JANUARY 6, 2012

1. No entry fee will be charged. Pre-entry by December 15, 2011 is encouraged. Pre-printed entry tags will be mailed to the exhibitor to attach to their exhibit(s) prior to delivery to the Farm Show.
2. Each ear corn entry shall consist of 10 ears. Each ear should be wrapped in paper and the exhibit securely crated. Entries having more or less than the required number of ears will be disqualified.
3. Shelled corn entries shall consist of 4 quarts of grain. Shelled corn samples should be from machine harvested grain and consist of all kernel sizes normally found on a corn ear. Entries will be judged on basis of test weights, free of mixed types, foreign material and visual evaluations.
4. Ornamental Indian corn (classes 7 and 8) may have the husk removed to facilitate judging.
5. Every exhibitor must place on inside of package containing his corn (ear exhibits) or attach to bag (Classes 9-11) a general entry form, giving name, address, county and class in which the exhibit is entered. Unclassed exhibits will be disqualified.
6. The general entry tag must include the name of the hybrid or open pollinated variety, the number of the hybrid and, the designation as to open pollinated, single or double cross hybrid.
7. Exhibitors may enter in as many classes as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than one entry in a single class, either in his own name, the name of a farm or the name of some other person, nor can he win more than one prize in a single class with one kind of corn.
8. Exhibitors must keep all marks of identity off exhibits until judging is completed.
9. One ear of each exhibit may be broken after corn is judged to better show its character.
10. Ears, marked with ink or in any other way that may hide cob discoloration or other blemishes will be disqualified.
11. In order to allow for a more even classification, the State has been divided into two districts (except for State-wide entries).
12. Judging will begin at 11:00 a.m., Friday, January 6, 2012.
13. All exhibits may be picked up by the exhibitor between 1 p.m. - 3 p.m. Saturday, January 14, 2012. Exhibits will be displayed in Exposition B, near Maclay Lobby. Any exhibit NOT claimed by 3 p.m. will become the property of the Farm Show.
