Entries Close 12:00 noon Friday, January, 6, 2012

1. No entry fee will be charged. Pre-entry by December 15, 2011 is encouraged. Pre-printed entry tags will be mailed to the exhibitor to attach to their exhibit(s) prior to delivery to the Farm Show. Social Security Number must be included on entry form to receive premiums.
2. Exhibitors may enter as many classes or divisions of a class as they wish, but no exhibitor shall make more than one entry in a single class or division of a class, either in his own name, the name of a farm or the name of some other person.
3. No professional florists are permitted to enter.
4. Flowers and plants entered for competition must be above the ordinary standard and quality to be entitled to an award.
5. Flowers need not be grown by the exhibitor. Must be cut flowers and greenery, no artificial.
6. Arrangements must be a minimum of 15" x 24" and maximum of 24" x 36". Exhibits not meeting size requirements will be disqualified.
7. Exhibits may be delivered beginning at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, January 5, 2012. Exhibits must arrive at the show by 12:00 noon, Friday, January 6, 2012. Deliver your entries in the Vegetable area
8. Show management will not undertake to return containers or be responsible for the return of exhibits. All exhibits may be picked up by the exhibitor between 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Saturday, January 14, 2012. Any exhibit not claimed by 3:00 p.m. will become the property of the Farm Show.
9. Judging will begin at 1:00 p.m., Friday, January 6, 2012.
10. Exhibits will be displayed in Exposition C, near Maclay Lobby.
