### ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6 p.m., THURSDAY, JANUARY 5, 2012

1. Entries limited to one entry per class for each firm, farm, corporation, or family. Registration is from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Thursday, January 5, 2012. Entries will be judged at 9:00 a.m. Friday, January 6, 2012. Pre-entry is encouraged. Send entry form to the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center, Vegetable Department, 2300 N. Cameron St., Harrisburg, PA 17110-9443 by December, 15, 2011 or register online at [www.farmshow.state.pa.us](http://www.farmshow.state.pa.us).
2. All vegetable department entries must have been grown in Pennsylvania since the 2011 Farm Show.
3. No exhibits or packages of vegetables entered in one class shall be eligible for premiums in any other class.
4. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit for competition in any class.
5. No premiums will be awarded in any class unless the exhibits are of optimum maturity and free of defect and soil. The judges may withhold any premiums for lack of merit or award second or third premiums only if deemed best. Misnamed varieties will not be considered eligible for premiums.
6. All entries become the property of the Farm Show, unless marked "*will call for*" and are claimed between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 14, 2012. If to be claimed by a representative, "*will call for*" must appear on the General Entry Blank.

- Class 2.** For both in-season and out-of-season vegetables (eight or more kind). Can include vegetables produced out-of-state but which can be grown in Pennsylvania.
- Class 3.** Gourds Mixed (Natural) - 15 or more attractively displayed in a one layer box or basket.
- Class 4.** Gourds Mixed (Laquered or coated) - 15 or more attractively displayed in a one layer box or basket.
- Class 5.** Potted herbs - 6 or more artistically arranged in a decorative basket.
- Class 6.** Grand Champion Market Basket - Rosette
