No Entry Fee

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 3:00 P.M., FRIDAY, JANUARY 6, 2012.

Pre-entry is encouraged. Send entry form by mail to the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex & Expo Center, Mushroom Department, 2300 N. Cameron St., Harrisburg, PA 17110-9443 by December, 15, 2011 or register online at www.farmshow.state.pa.us.

1. No entry fee will be charged and no charge will be made for exhibit space.

2. No exhibits or package of mushrooms entered in one class shall be eligible for premiums in any other class, except as plainly noted in premium list. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit for competition in any class or division of a class.

3. No premiums will be awarded in any class unless the exhibits are worthy. Judges may withhold any premiums for lack of merit or may award second or third premiums only if deemed best. Misnamed varieties will not be considered eligible for premiums.

4. Judging will begin at 4:00 p.m., Friday, January 6, 2012.

5. All entries remain the property of the exhibitor providing the same are claimed between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 14, 2012. No entries may be removed before the close of the show. If to be claimed by the exhibitor or his representative, “. . . *will call for*” must appear on the General Entry Blank. Unless called for within the allotted time, the exhibits become the property of the show.

6. After 3:00 p.m., Friday, January 6, 2012, mushroom entries will be accepted for display only, not for competitive judging.
