1. Health: See Cattle health rules, page 18
2. **IMPORTANT : GROOMING** - Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, don't use it! ****IMPORTANT**!** If upon slaughter, treatment with drugs, biologics, or any chemical from fitting products, is the cause of the condemnation of a carcass, the loss of the carcass and any other damages will be borne by the exhibitor. **UNETHICAL FITTING:** Any animal showing any evidence of unethical fitting practices such as tampering with the natural fleshing and muscle development (including but NOT limited to drenching and pumping of fluids) will be barred from the show and no premiums awarded. **No exhibitors shall be allowed to use any coloring agents on any animal exhibited. The Farm Show may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white glove" or "white towel" test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated make up areas. Designated make-up areas will be the Spine and arena areas.**
3. Each exhibitor may enter and exhibit no more than two entries in any one class. The open show entry fee is \$15 per animal and must accompany the entry application. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that entries are made correctly and on time.**
4. Ownership: Females may show with joint ownership provided one of the owners is the exhibitor. Bulls may show with joint ownership provided one of the owners is the exhibitor and that the bull is maintained on the exhibitor's farm at least four months of the preceding year. To be eligible for showing, the original registration certificate must be presented and must show the transfer of ownership of purchased animals, or the registry of cattle bred by the exhibitor, no later than the date entries close for the Farm Show.
5. **Tattoo identification:** All animals to be eligible to show must have a legible tattoo which agrees with the registration certificate.
6. **Animals Entered and Not Shown:** A penalty of \$50.00 per animal will be assessed to the owner for each beef animal entered and not exhibited at the Farm show. Entries cancelled on or before December 27, 2011 will cause forfeiture of entry fees without penalty. In extreme or unusual circumstances, a written appeal of the assessment of the penalty or vet excuse will be considered, if received by the Farm Show Director on or before Monday, January 9, 2012.
7. An All Other Purebred division is established for those breeds that fail to meet the minimum 15-head exhibited rule and for those breeds not represented by an individual breed show. All Other Purebred is defined as registered animals whose sire and dam both arise from the same purebred registry. Registered percentage cattle are not eligible
8. **NO ONE may prepare beds before 3 p.m. January 3, 2012.** The available room for beef cattle is limited. Pens and stalls will be assigned on the basis of the number of entries by each exhibitor. Each exhibitor's area will be clearly marked and there will be a chart posted on the wall listing stalling assignments at the entrance of the feed room. All exhibitors will use the pens or stalls assigned them. These facilities are to be used only to tie or enclose livestock. In the case of animals entered but not exhibited, management will reassign excess pens or stalls as deemed necessary.
9. Exhibitors with 1-4 cattle may purchase up to two extra three-foot spaces, \$15.00 per extra space, and exhibitors with more than 4 cattle may purchase up to four three-foot spaces for a total \$60 if purchased prior to entry deadline.
10. **BLOCKING CHUTES:** A twenty-five (25) dollar fee must be paid prior to November 3, 2011 for each blocking chute to be used during the Pennsylvania Farm Show. **NEW RULE:** Each firm, farm, or family is limited to one chute for 1 to 3 animals, two chutes for 4 to 6 animals, etc. A fee of \$50 must be paid for the first chute above these limits and \$100 each for all others. A sticker will be furnished by show management to serve as proof of payment. Blocking chutes must have this sticker affixed to the right, rear upright at eye level. All chutes must be kept out of aisles and in designated areas or they will be removed from the grounds.
11. **Check In:** Open only Shorthorn, Maine-Anjou, MaineTainer, Texas Longhorn and All Other Purebred breeding cattle entries will be checked in on Thursday, January 5, 2012 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. All other Open and Junior breeding cattle entries will be checked in from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Saturday, January 7, 2012. Angus cattle will be checked-in Saturday, January 7 at 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. Exhibitors must furnish original breed registration papers at that time. No photostats, facsimilies or copies will be accepted. Tattoos will also be checked at that time. All required tattoos must be legible and match registration papers.
12. **Release Time:** All beef cattle are dismissed at 6 p.m. on Monday, January 9, 2012. Cattle in the North barn must vacate the North barn by 9 p.m. Monday, January 9, 2012. All Cattle housed in the Northwest barn must vacate the Northwest barn by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, January 10, 2012. Cattle may remain in tie-outs for the remainder of Farm Show.
13. **Split of large classes:** Farm Show Management shall have the option of splitting any beef cattle class of unreasonable size. Full premiums will be awarded in each class.
14. **Group Classes:** Family members' animals registered in junior members' names and entered in the open show may be treated as family entries in the group classes, as long as juniors are 19 years old or less as of January 1st of current year. For the purpose of Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder points, an exhibitor will be considered a Jr. member and their family as one, as explained above.
15. A breed is defined as a recognized breed registry with a closed herd book. In the case of recognized breeds with an open herd book, the individuals entered in the show must be no less than 15/16 of a single breed (as defined above) and recorded in the registry with a regular registration number (not an appendix number).
16. **Supreme Champions:** A Supreme Champion Bull and a Supreme Champion Female will be selected from the Grand Champions of all breeds at the conclusion of the beef cattle show on Monday, January 9, 2012.
17. **Premiums:** The Farm Show contribution to premiums will be the same for all breeds, except Angus, as follows:

OPEN CLASS • PARTICIPATION STATEMENT

AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION

The American Angus Association®, 3201 Frederick Avenue, St. Joseph, Mo., will participate in premiums offered for open class Angus breeding cattle classes according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The premium assistance provided by the American Angus Association for participation in this show is in addition to the premiums offered by the show itself. The premium assistance should not be used to offset show expense and shall be included in the premium payments distributed by the show to the exhibitors.

A minimum of 50 head must be shown in the open class division to receive American Angus Association premium participation for the following year.

Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay on championship or any group classes, (i.e. get-of-sire, junior get-of-sire or breeder six-head).

Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association available for inspection at the show for each animal or another current proof of ownership issued by the American Angus Association pedigree look up. Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.

Any female shown with a calf at side: the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show day and have proof of registration at check in.

Only one person at a time shall lead an animal into the show ring.

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders Reference Guide of the Association. These rules are found in Part 2; Association Rules. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800 - 810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

At any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents, on any animal exhibited. The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white towel" or "white glove" test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated line up areas.

All animals exhibited are subject to DNA marker or blood type test to verify accuracy of parentage as covered under the Association Rules and for other testing as required by the individual show.

Authorized representatives of the Association have the authority to enforce the rules set forth herein as well as in the Association Rules, including the barring of a registered animal from a livestock show at which it is to be shown, if there are reasonable grounds to believe a violation has occurred.

OPEN SHOW • AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION

SHOW CLASSIFICATION FOR ANGUS

Any classes listed in this classification, which exceeds 15 head per class, should be broken into smaller classes. This should be accomplished by dividing the class as evenly as possible without splitting animals with the same birth date.

Example 1: If 16 head are entered in class 4, the class should be broken into two classes of 8; a class of 7 and 9; or a class of 10 and 6.

Example 2: If 32 head are entered in class 4, the class should be divided into three classes consisting of two classes with 11 head and one class of 10 head or similar without putting animals with the same birth date in different classes.

Class breaks will be at the discretion of the American Angus Association staff in attendance.

Only registered Angus cattle that meet the age requirements listed within this classification are eligible to receive premium participation and be counted in the total number of head shown - Champion and Reserve Champion placings are not counted in number of head shown

Any female that qualifies for female classes in the Association's standard classifications are not eligible to show in the cow/calf classes. However, the calf at the side of the female is eligible to show in its respective class.

1. ALL CATTLE MUST BE PUREBRED TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW.
2. **Entry in this show binds the exhibitor to all regulations pertaining thereto.**
3. No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two prizes in any one class.
4. All animals must be registered as the property of the exhibitor in the records of the American Shorthorn Association as of the date entries close for the Farm Show.
5. Individual animals shown in all of the group classes listed below must have been entered and shown in one of the following classes for single animals.
6. Multiple owned animals must be exhibited in the name of all owners.
7. Family bred and raised animals entered by Juniors in Junior Classes and subsequently entered in Open Classes may be treated as family entries in group classes. Exhibitor points may be awarded to an exhibitor for animals owned in partnership with non-exhibitors.
8. **Revisions of the Senior/Junior Yearling Pregnancy Rule for exhibitors at all open shows:** Any senior/junior yearling female 28 months of age or older on the date of the show must have a natural calf at side and must be shown with such. All females 20 months of age or older on the date of the show must have a 60 day pregnancy verification signed by an accredited, non-owner veterinarian at the time the female is processed for the show. If a verification cannot be produced, the female may be allowed to participate if the exhibitor can produce a qualified veterinarian to examine the female at the show site, and verify a 60 day pregnancy. Any infractions against this rule will lead to disqualification of that individual.
9. All Shorthorns are subject to a tattoo inspection by representatives of the Association. All Shorthorns are also subject to an age inspection if deemed necessary by the American Shorthorn Association and the **decision of the examining veterinarian is final.** Use of artificial fins on show animals is not permitted.

12. Any and all cattle shall be made available to have blood drawn for parentage verification, detection of foreign substances or the presence of altering. 1. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the American Maine-Anjou Association. When entry is made, exhibitors agree to abide by the rules and regulations established by the AMAA as well as the rules of the show management. Entries found to be misrepresented, or persons not abiding by the show rules may be disqualified from showing.
2. All animals must be registered in the AMAA or CMAA and the original registration certificate presented at check-in.
3. All animals must be 25% (1/4) to 62.5% (5/8) Maine Anjou.
4. Tattoos will be checked, must be legible, and correspond exactly with the registration certificate. Other than brucellosis calfhooftattoo, there shall be no permanent identification marks other than those noted on the certificate of registry.
5. The attempted surgical or non-surgical alteration of conformation of an animal is prohibited, except for de-horning. Cattle must be shown in their natural condition.
6. The use of false tailheads or adding hair or other material to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.
7. The dyeing or artificial changing of the existing color pattern and color will be prohibited.
8. All animals over 7 months of age must be de-horned.
9. Heifers exhibited at 20 months of age or older must be accompanied by a certificate of pregnancy. For heifers used in embryo transfer, a certificate of positive fertility issued by a licensed veterinarian must be available for inspection.
10. Any and all cattle shall be made available to have blood drawn for parentage verification, detection of foreign substances or the presence of altering. If recorded parent is excluded as a result of the blood typing, the owner may at his or her expense, request the AMAA to determine the actual parent. Failure to determine parentage will result in disqualification of that animal from the AMAA herd book.
11. Cows exhibited with calves at side must be lactating. Calves must not exceed 240 days of age on the day of judging and must still be nursing. Calf entries in the Cow/Calf class may be shown individually, provided proper entry has been made. Champion Cow/Calf pair is eligible for Champion Female.

2. All ITLA Show Rules and Regulations Apply. This show is for Haltered Animals Only!
3. All Cattle must be registered with the International Texas Longhorn Association or Texas Longhorn Breeders Association. A photocopy of the registration papers must accompany each entry form. No cattle with pending registration will be accepted. Registrations other than ITLA will be charged an extra \$5.00 and this fee will be used to dual register, if so desired.
4. A calf shown with a cow shall not be older than 210 days of age. A calf shall be at least 180 days of age to show in individual class. Calf at side may show in only one class – as calf at side with dam or in an individual class. Calves shown at side must be haltered and led by an exhibitor.
5. Animals must be kept under control at all times while in the show ring. If an animal shall become unmanageable, the judge may at their discretion, remove said animal from competition and all entry fees shall be forfeited.

1. All applications for entries must be made on printed forms, giving class, number, age, and all other necessary information. These forms must be signed by the exhibitor and certified by a county agent, or vocational agriculture supervisor. These forms must be filed with the Director of the Pennsylvania Farm Show on or before November 3, 2011.
2. All entries must have been owned by and in the possession of the exhibitor and registered in his or her name by November 3, 2011. Leased animals: See Rule 9, page 17.
3. Health rules - See page 18 for health rules. All entries in these classes will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations on page 16.
4. Grooming Products: Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat producing animals when fitting any animal for show. Unapproved products may contain ingredients that result in unacceptable residues in the meat. If it is not certain that a product is residue safe and approved for use on meat animals, don't use it!
5. No entry fee will be charged unless the animal is to be shown also in the open class in which case the fee of \$15.00 per head must accompany the entry form.
6. A penalty of \$50 per animal will be assessed to the owner for each Beef animal entered and not exhibited in the Farm Show. Entries cancelled on or before November 3, 2011, will permit a refund of entry fees with no penalty. Entry cancellations received after November 3 and before December 27, 2011; will cause forfeiture of entry fees without penalty. In extreme or unusual circumstances, a written appeal of the assessment of the penalty will be considered, if received by the Farm Show Director on or before Monday, January 9, 2012.
7. **ELIGIBILITY: SEE RULE 13, PAGE 16.** - Junior & Youth Division classes eligibility. These classes are open to 4-H Club members and Vocational Agriculture students. **Exhibitors must have been born in the years 1992-2002.**
8. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
9. Substitutions within classes for reasons satisfactory to management will be permitted on the opening day of the Show, provided the animal to be substituted was owned by the exhibitor on or before November 3, 2011.

13. Bedding - Shredded wood fiber, 4" - 6" deep, will be provided by the Farm Show. No other type of bedding is permitted in the beef cattle area.

15. Angus exhibitors must have an original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association on each animal available for inspection at the show. Jr. Beef Showmanship skills will be recognized by designating "Master Showmen" in each steer and breeding class. Exhibitors who demonstrate extraordinary skills in showing their animals will be selected by a separate showmanship judge during the show. The number will be recorded and the exhibitor will be awarded a special Farm Show Award. There will be no further showmanship competition for Jr. Beef exhibitors.

The PA Angus Association will award a plaque or banner to the owners of the Champion & Reserve Champion heifer bred & owned by the exhibitor.

AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION JUNIOR ANGUS HEIFER SHOW • PARTICIPATION STATEMENT

The American Angus Association®, 3201 Frederick Avenue, St. Joseph, Mo., will participate in premiums offered in individual classes for junior Angus heifers, as included in its standard show classifications, according to the premium schedule based on the number of head shown. The premium assistance provided by the American Angus Association for participation in this show is in addition to the premiums offered by the show itself. The premium assistance should not be used to offset show expense and shall be included in the premium payments distributed by the show to the exhibitors.

A minimum of fifteen (15) head must be shown in the junior Angus heifer classes to receive American Angus Association premium participation. The show is not required to have all classes to be eligible for premiums.

Separate classes for bred and owned heifers may be held if the size of the show merits a separate class.

To be eligible for Association premiums the entries must be recorded in the sole name of the junior exhibitor and the issue date on the registration certificate must conform to the individual show's requirements regarding ownership. The Association's contribution is included in the total premiums listed in each class.

Premiums from the Association are paid only to registered Angus cattle and only if the registration number is a part of the show report provided to the Association. Therefore, all cattle should be registered at the time of entry to make certain they receive the Association's portion of premiums. The Association does not pay on premiums offered in championship classes. An animal may only be counted one time toward the total count for premium participation by the Association.

Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate issued by the American Angus Association available for inspection at the show for each animal or another current proof of ownership issued by the American Angus Association pedigree look up. Any animal, upon check-in, which does not have a legible permanent identification mark (ear tattoo marks, freeze-branded marks or hot-branded marks) corresponding to the permanent identification mark on the registration certificate, is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible permanent identification mark, animals cannot be re-identified (tattooed/branded) and rechecked at the show.

Any female shown with a calf at side: the calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf, and the calf must be registered by show day and have proof of registration at check in.

Only one person at a time shall lead an animal into the show ring.

Exhibitors who participate in shows that accept premium monies contributed by the American Angus Association are subject to the Association Rules as found in the Breeders Reference Guide of the Association. These rules are found in Part 2; Association Rules. The rules relating directly with the exhibition of Angus cattle are Part 2: Association Rules; Rule 800 Series; including Rule 800 - 810. These rules can be found at www.angus.org.

Altering the conformation and/or appearance of an animal for exhibition is prohibited. This includes the covering of white skin, false tail heads (or use of any false hair), with the exception of false tail switches. The use of graphite, powders, hemp or other similar substances used externally are also prohibited. Other prohibited products include those used internally such as steroids, illegal or unlicensed pharmaceuticals or artificial filling. Any animal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

At any show for which the American Angus Association appropriates funds toward the payment of premiums, no exhibitors, individuals assisting exhibitors or member owners at such show shall be allowed to use any coloring agents, on any animal exhibited. The Association may adopt and implement various tests designed to monitor this prohibition, including but not limited to a "white towel" or "white glove" test. No aerosol cans or other pressurized containers will be allowed in designated line up areas.

All animals exhibited are subject to DNA marker or blood type test to verify accuracy of parentage as covered under the Association Rules and for other testing as required by the individual show.

Authorized representatives of the Association have the authority to enforce the rules set forth herein as well as in the Association Rules, including the barring of a registered animal from a livestock show at which it is to be shown, if there are reasonable grounds to believe a violation has occurred.

AMERICAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION STANDARD CLASSIFICATION FOR JUNIOR HEIFER SHOWS

Any classes listed in this classification, which exceeds 15 head per class, should be broken into smaller classes. This should be accomplished by dividing the class as evenly as possible without splitting animals with the same birth date.

Example 1: If 16 head are entered in class 4, the class should be broken into two classes of 8; a class of 7 and 9; or a class of 10 and 6.

Example 2: If 32 head are entered in class 4, the class should be divided into three classes consisting of two classes with 11 head and one class of 10 head or similar without putting animals with the same birth date in different classes.

Class breaks will be at the discretion of the American Angus Association staff in attendance.
